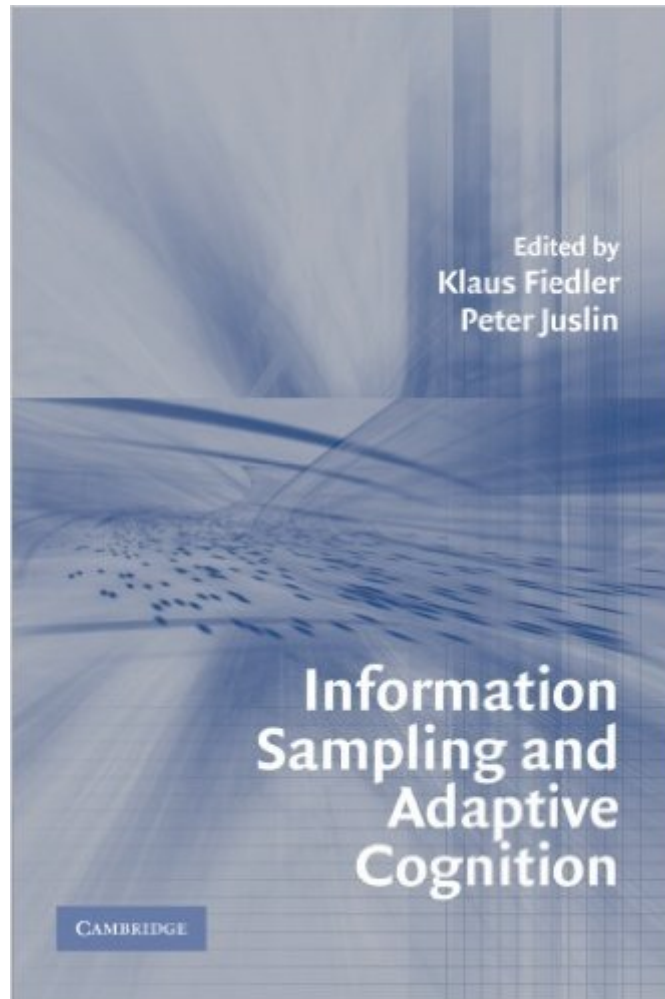


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Information Sampling And Adaptive Cognition



Synopsis

Even the most intelligent and informed judges and decision makers have been shown to be prone to errors and biases with potentially serious consequences. Previous scientific attempts to explain the causes of wrong decisions have mainly focused on shortcomings in the cognitive processing of the information given. Although the input of environmental information samples may be biased, the cognitive processing of information samples is often unbiased and remarkably accurate.

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
